The Hellenic Ministry of Culture and Sports / General Directorate of Antiquities and Cultural Heritage / Directorate of Prehistoric and Classical Antiquities organized the 4th project meeting within the approved project "Integrating Bulgaria-Greece cross-border significance historical and archeological assets into one sustainable thematic tourist destination - BORDERLESS CULTURE", supported by Cooperation Programme "INTERREG V-A Greece-Bulgaria" 2014 - 2020. The 4th project meeting was hosted in the Conference Room of the Region of Central Macedonia's building, Vassilisis Olgas 198, Thessaloniki, Greece on Monday 30/09/2019. The 4th project started at 10:30 and ended at 13:30.

Starting the project meeting, Mr Papadopoulos Konstantinos, Project Manager of Directorate of Prehistoric and Classical Antiquities of Hellenic Ministry of Culture and Sports, in cooperation with the representatives of project partners presented project's progress and specifically the deliverables and activities which have already implemented as well as the current progress of the rest deliverables which are implementing at this period and the problems that have arose.

During the meeting, all project beneficiaries representatives discussed and updated the timetable of the project. Because of the delay in contracting of project partners' deliverables, all project partners agreed to request for an 8-month time extension of the of the date set for closing the project implementation activities (until 31/07/2020) in order to secure the successful implementation of project objectives and expected results.

Finally, project partners presented the amounts that will be paid and verified until the end of the year as well as until the end of project extension which will be requested and argued that the rest events will be organized at the end of the project included the possible time extension which will receive the project.
